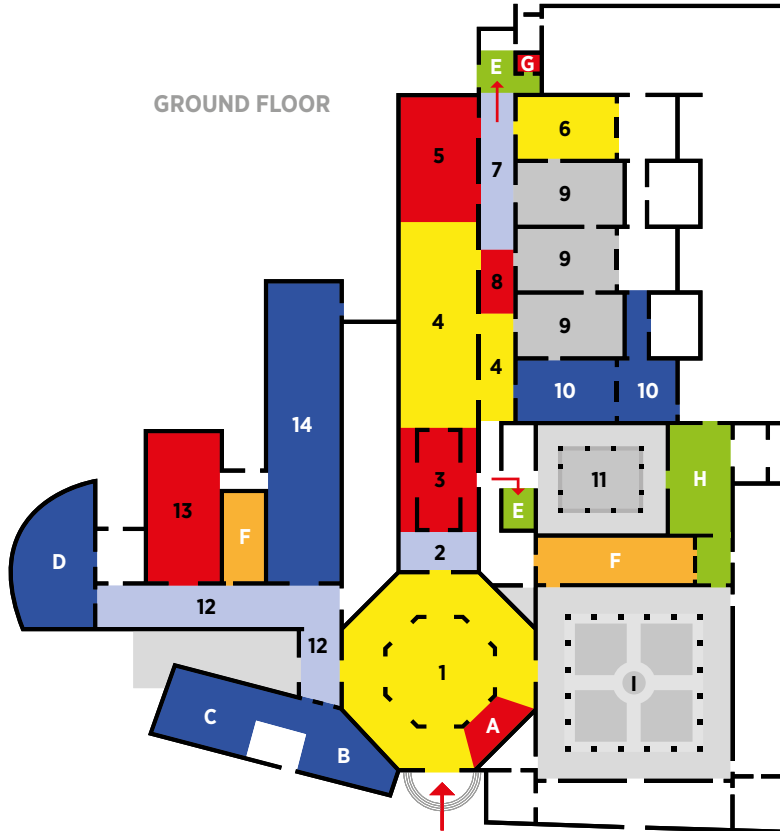

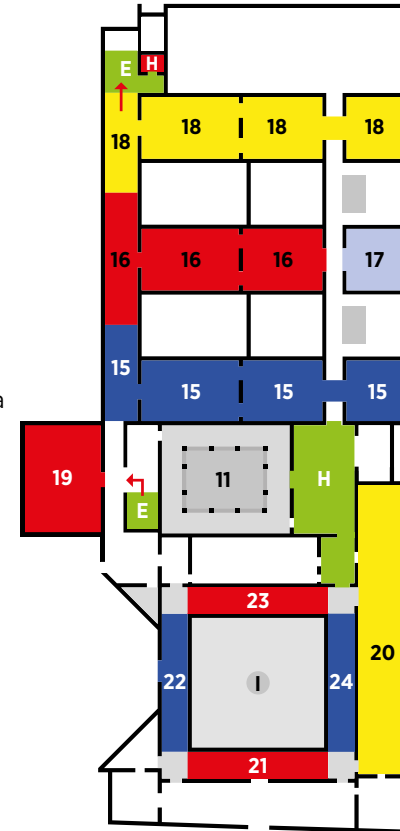

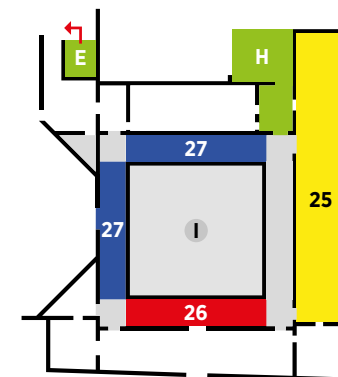

VISITOR INFORMATION

- Smoking is forbidden in the museum, including its open-air spaces.
